We embrace the diversity of Leicester and aim to ensure all women, regardless of their culture, background or faith have equal opportunity to access services.

Respect	We are committed to the women we serve and their wellbeing is central to our work
Equal access	We commit to serving women in the sex industry on a long term basis, irrespective of their individual choices. Provision of our services is in no way dependent on their response to our beliefs.
New opportunities	We encourage women to make informed choices and take up new opportunities. We believe all women should have the chance to progress, achieve, and thrive.
